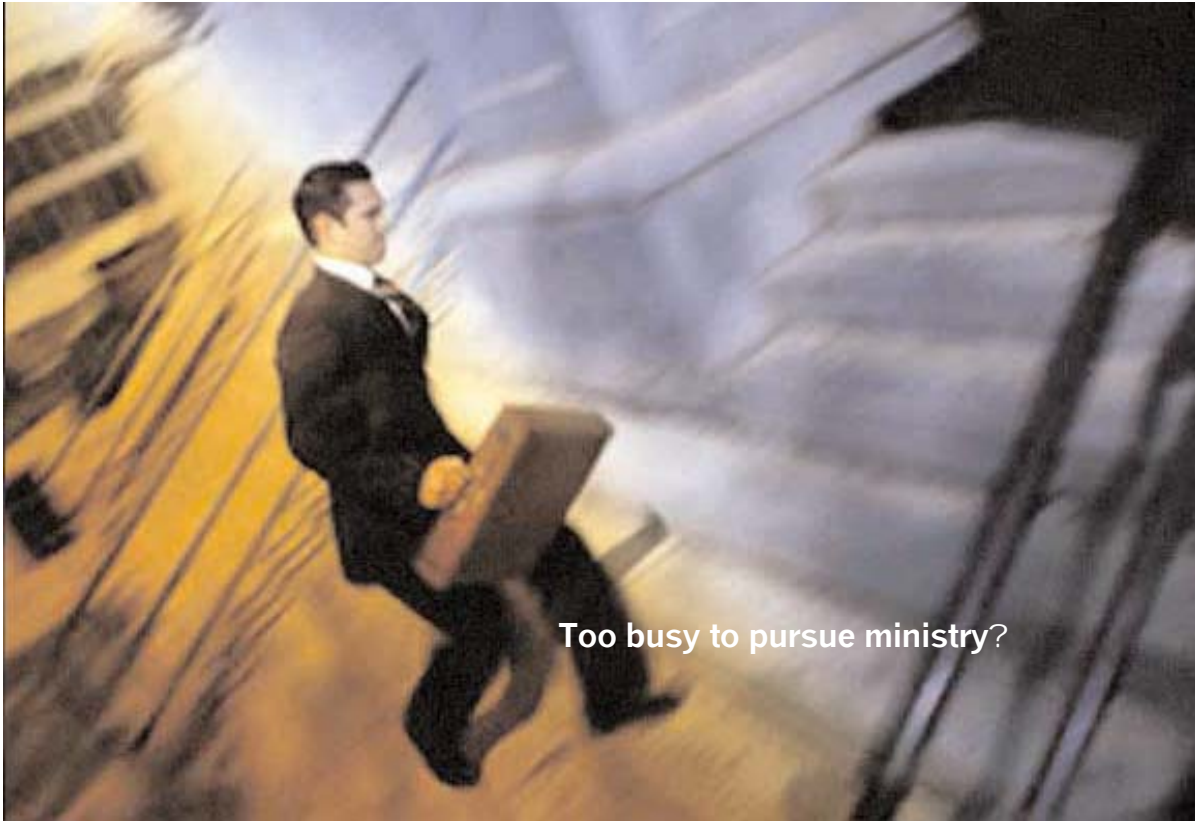

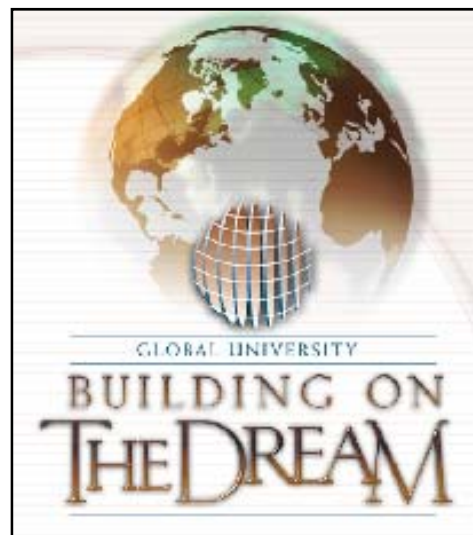

Descriptions of Christian Life – level subjects:

All of these courses are intended to develop the new Christian's understanding of their faith in a personal and practical way. Each study is on average 110 pages of study.

SPIRITUAL LIFE

Your New Life

This introductory study helps the new Christian to gain a realization of what their new life in Christ is all about.

When You Pray

Through prayer we learn to reach out to God for help. This course shows us how to get our prayers answered, and have our needs met as we pray and worship God.

God's Design – Your Choice

This course will help you to find out more about God's design for you, and the many ways in which God will help you if you choose to follow Him.

THE BIBLE

Your Bible

This course will introduce the student to the Bible, helping them to study it in order to gain an insight into the way that God views their circumstances and helps them when they ask Him.

How to Study the Bible

This course explains the importance of studying the Bible, while at the same time giving the student practical insight into how they can effectively organize their personal biblical studies.

John's Gospel

This course follows the pattern of John's Gospel, centering on the person of Jesus Christ. It deals with many of the intimate details of Jesus' life, His teachings, and His claims that are not found in the other Gospels.

THEOLOGY

Who Jesus Is

The best place to learn about the identity of Jesus is the Bible. This course gives us a vivid look at the life of Jesus, beginning with His birth and continuing to the prophecies about His second coming.

Your Helpful Friend

This course introduces the student to their special friend, the Holy Spirit. Many students have experienced the Baptism in the Holy Spirit after studying this course.

We Believe

This is a course that deals with the fundamental doctrines of the Bible and touches on the issues that every Christian should know, outlining their relevance for today's society.



THE CHURCH

The Church

This course gives the believer a better understanding of their place in the church, showing them how to go about fulfilling their potential as one of the indispensable parts of the body of Christ.

Christian Worship

This study will help those who seek to maintain consistent private devotions by illustrating the need for and benefit of worship. It also gives some essential guidelines that will be beneficial for group worship.

What Churches Do

This course looks at many of the most frequently asked questions, and ethical issues in relation to the church.

Personal Evangelism

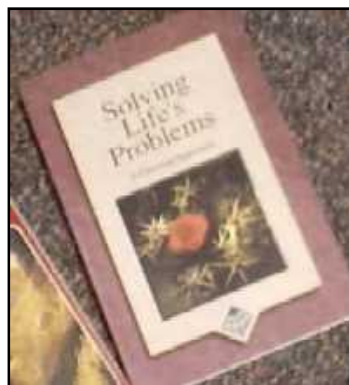
This course will help the reader understand the true nature of evangelism, enabling them to share Christ with the people around them in a more convincing and powerful way.

Bible Ethics

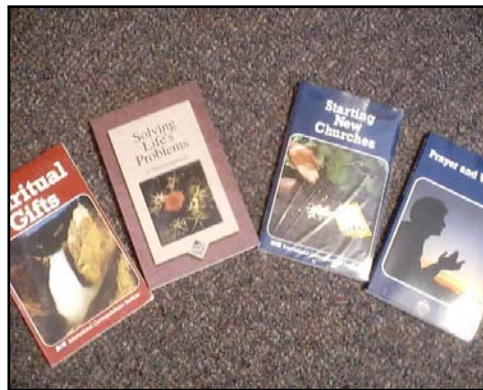

Descriptions of Christian Service – level subjects:

All of these courses are intended to develop the Christian in the practice of their faith. Each study is on average 225 pages of study.

SPIRITUAL LIFE

Christian Maturity

This course is an introductory study to the subject of the Christian's growth. The study gives attention to the role of Christian service in the believer's growth, also pointing out how the student may progress towards Christ likeness in daily Christian living and service.

Prayer & Worship

This course is a study on prayer and worship with emphasis on the priority of God's glory and God's kingdom over man's needs and wants. It also emphasizes the fact that all things that are needed will be provided for the believer who honours his priority.

The Responsible Christian

This study looks at what the Bible says about stewardship- the role of God as owner and man as steward-explaining how the Christian should exercise his responsibility for faithful management of the things for which God has entrusted him. In addition, it will deal with his relationship to his home, church, and community as a steward.

THE BIBLE

Kingdom, Power & Glory

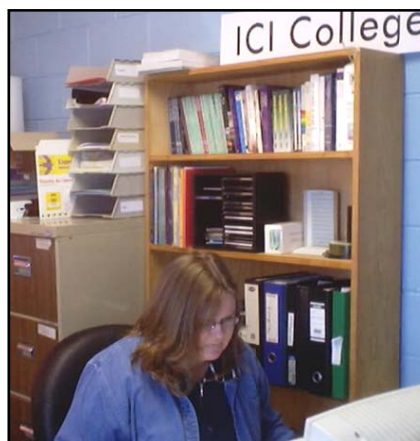
This course gives the student an overall knowledge of the content of the New Testament through its emphasis on the historical setting, characteristics, and teachings in its books. It will help the Christian worker become better equipped to share the New Testament's truth with others.

Tents, Temples & Palaces

This introduction to the Old Testament deals with the sequence and meaning of the experiences of God's people, paying special attention to God's mighty acts and prophetic words. The student will discover many truths in this course, which will help them in their personal walk with God and understanding of the Bible.

Understanding the Bible

In this course, you will gain an understanding of the value of skilled procedures of observation and interpretation as aids to understanding the Bible. Its purpose is to help you apply Biblical truth to your own life and share it with others.



CORNERSTONES OF TRUTH

This practical, systematic study of basic Bible doctrines includes a look at the topics of: the nature of God; the acts of God; the activities and limitations of angels; Creation; the fall of man; God's redemptive plan; the origin of the Scriptures; the church; and, God's ultimate plan for mankind.

Alive in Christ

This study presents salvation as both the will and work of God, which rest upon the atoning work of Christ. Included in this study are the biblical teachings of repentance, faith, conversion, regeneration, justification, adoption, sanctification, and glorification.

Counselor, Teacher & Guide

In this course, the Holy Spirit is presented as a personal, powerful, and practical Friend who abides in the Spirit-filled believer, and through him reveals Jesus Christ to the world. This is a practical guide for a student who desires a spirit-filled life.

THE CHURCH

Christian Church in Ministry

This course is designed to help the student gain a better understanding of: 1) the importance of the church in God's plan for the world; 2) the importance of the Christian's role in Christ's plan for the church; and, 3) how they can become involved in doing God's will through ministry in the church.

Starting new Churches

This practical course stresses the importance of establishing new churches as a means of evangelizing the world. It gives guidelines to help any church become involved in the task of planting churches, thereby becoming a multiplying church.

Helping Christians Grow

This is a study of the biblical basis for the nurturing ministry and the practical application of teaching in the church today. It gives emphasis to the needs of the pupils in various stages of human development and to the various opportunities for Christian nurturing through the ministry of local church programs, sharing groups, and the Christian home.

SERVICE

Spiritual Gifts

In this course, the student will look at the three different types of spiritual gifts: 1) Ministry: including church leadership; 2) Other Ministry Gifts: ministry gifts available to all believers; and, 3) Gifts of the Spirit: the nine gifts of the Spirit available to all believers.

Preaching & Teaching

This course is a basic study of two Biblical methods of communicating God's word. The student is guided in the understanding and mastery of practical ways to prepare and present lessons and sermons from Scripture.

Sharing the Good News

This practical course is designed to teach the student how to lead people to put their trust in Jesus Christ as their Savior and Lord, as well as helping the student learn how to teach personal evangelism to others. Special emphasis is given to the dynamic ministry of the Holy Spirit and the Word of God in effecting conversions.

CHRISTIAN ETHICS

Solving Life's Problems

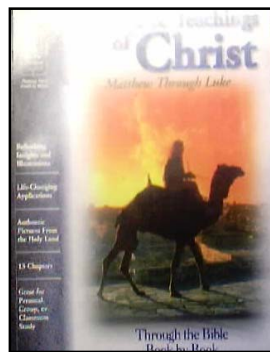
This study focuses on the sources of problems, methods of problem solving, and ways of finding solutions, from a Christian perspective. Biblical solutions are given for all problem areas- including that of sexuality, relationships, suffering, and death- which provide a solid foundation for the Christian to find solutions for their problems.

People, Tasks & Goals

This course introduces the student to the theory and practice of leadership, and guides them through the application of both biblical and theoretical principles. The main emphasis of this course is upon development of gifts and capacities, and interpersonal relationships among leaders and followers.

Abundant Living

This course emphasizes the development of Christian qualities and their out workings in the Christian's relationships and services. Biblical definitions and examples are emphasized in describing the nine dimensions of spiritual fruit. Practical applications are made which relate these characteristics to the individual Christian life.

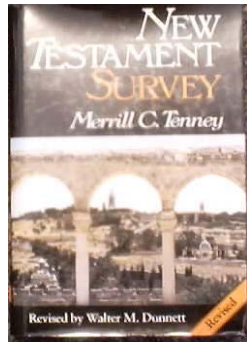

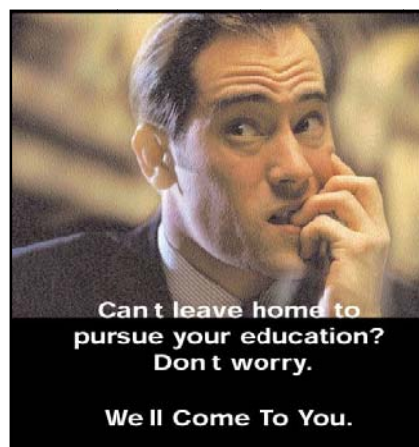

Supervisor and Student Final Exam Instructions

To ensure the integrity of the evaluation system, ICI College requires that the Final Exam for each course be taken in the presence of an exam supervisor. The selection of a Supervisor is the responsibility of the student. Examples of acceptable Supervisors include pastors, church elders, librarians, teachers, or other professional people.

GUIDELINES FOR THIS SELECTION:

- The Supervisor must not be a relative of the student.
- The Supervisor needs to be able to monitor the student while the exam is being given.
- The Exam supervisor form must accompany your application as a new student.
- The Supervisor must not reside at the same address as the student.

PROCESS FOR REQUESTING AND COMPLETING THE FINAL EXAM:

The student needs to select a potential Supervisor and have them complete and sign the Supervisors Application form.

The student should then fill in any additional information required, and sign the Exam Supervisor application form. This then needs to be mailed to us, within 7 days of your enrolment.

ICI College will mail the Final Exam to the approved Supervisor, when the student requests this. All UPE's, Projects or Collateral readings must be completed before or as you are requesting the exam.

The student will need to arrange a convenient time with the Exam Supervisor to take the Final Exam.

The Supervisor monitors the student during the Final Exam, assuring that no inappropriate aids (such as books, notes, study guides, reference works, or dictionaries) were used by the student while completing the Final Exam (a non marked or non study edition of a Bible is allowed).


A maximum time limit is allowed for different levels of studies, please check the Final Exam when received for maximum time limit allowed.

The Supervisor signs & dates the Final Examination Scantron™ answer sheet indicating he/she has monitored the student during the Final Exam and returns the Exam and the completed Scantron™ answer sheet directly to ICI College in the envelope provided. The Supervisor is asked to mail back the exam within 24 hours after the student writing it.

In the event the student does not take the Final Exam, the Supervisor must return the exam to ICI. It is required that this exam be returned within 7 days of the date on which the student was scheduled to write it.

Should the Student or Supervisor have any questions, comments, or concerns regarding the above instructions, they are to contact ICI College.
